Attempts to obtain advanced placement in Computer Science or Computer Engineering courses must be arranged and approved in advance by and advisor in the Department of Computer Science and Engineering. This form must be completed and approved before taking the advanced course.

The student must earn an "A" or "B" on the first attempt to receive advanced placement credit for the lower level course(s) in that sequence. If the student withdraws, drops, fails to obtain at least a "B", he or she must take the course(s) for which advance placement was attempted. There is a standard fee that must be paid for credit hours awarded by advanced placement before the hours are recorded on the transcript. The form is the "Credit by Exam" form and is presented to the Office of the Registrar and Bursar.
