General Electives Policy

The general elective policy applies to the B.S. and B.A. in Computer Science and the B.S. in Computer Engineering programs.

The purpose of the general elective category is to give students the flexibility to introduce breadth into their studies or to complement their major with a minor in another discipline.

All courses taken at WSU that meet the following guidelines will be accepted as general electives:

1. Courses must be taken for a grade.
2. Courses must be at level 100 or higher.
3. Courses will not count if they substantially duplicate other courses already taken.
4. CS and CEG courses, including CS 340, CS 399, CS 499, CEG 399 and CEG 499, may be taken as general electives.

Students should meet with a department advisor if they are unclear on the guidelines or the acceptability of any course.

When a student enters a computer science or computer engineering degree program, courses taken at other universities or colleges will be reviewed by a department advisor for applicability as a general elective. Courses taken at other universities or colleges while the student is in the Computer Science or Computer Engineering program must receive prior approval from a department advisor to be counted as a general elective.
